**ATR VERDICT:** BORGI secured a victory by a length over an extended mile at Wolverhampton earlier in the month and he was only put up 3lb for that triumph. The five-year-old remains in the same grade here and could be the one to beat. Alazwar has finished in the first two on each of his last three starts and could go well off a 1lb higher mark than his latest second at Wolverhampton, while Desert Doctor can be in the mix for the minor honours after his runner-up effort at Lingfield.
