**ATR VERDICT:** The Caltonian is respected in his bid for a sixth win since the beginning of October. However, he has gone up 32lb in the handicap during the same time period and, with all bar one of those successes registered in a lower grade, the latest 7lb increase for a C&D success 11 days ago leaves him vulnerable.
